**A Reading from the Holy Gospel according to John, 14:1-6**

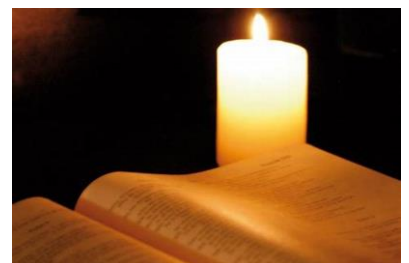
**All: Glory to You O Lord**
